1. This will be a double elimination Calcutta. That means the names will be eliminated from the board only after being drawn from the drum twice. \$1000 will be awarded to the second from last name drawn. The grand prize of \$3500 will be awarded to the only name left. In addition to these two prizes, the first name eliminated will be awarded \$125 and there will be thirteen other cash prizes of \$125 each to every 10th name eliminated.
